

It is diverse, with an emphasis on whiskey, and also comprises an extensive selection of cognac, tequila, mezcal, rum, amari and liqueurs among others. The collection ebbs and flows with time and the changing tastes, interests, and values of our people. It spans dozens of countries and represents the traditions and cultures of hundreds of regions. With over 2,000 bottles, you could try a new spirit every day for the next five years, and there would still be more to discover.

Whether you are interested in the arts of distillation, the interplay of textures and flavors in a well-made cocktail, or are drawn to the history, stories, or ethos of your favorite spirits makers, we invite you to connect to the collection in your own way.

Reservations for larger parties can be made by emailing the front desk at info@mwlpdx.com or by calling (503)954-1381. If you do not see an open reservation online for your preferred date or time, please call or email the front desk, as we may still be able to accommodate your party.

This text line is only monitored during opening hours and is used primarily for same day information such as updates and cancellations or to add your name to the wait list for an available table.
